AFFIDAVIT OF LICENSED FUNERAL DIRECTOR
PURSUANT TO SECTION 3101 OF THE
PENNSYLVANIA PROBATE, ESTATES AND FIDUCIARIES CODE

Section 3101 (b) of the Pennsylvania Probate, Estates and Fiduciaries Code provides that a credit union may, at any time after the death of a member, pay the amount on deposit of the deceased member to the spouse, any child, the father or mother, or any sister or brother (preference being given in the order named), provided that (1) the amount on deposit does not exceed Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) and (2) either of the following was presented to the credit union: (a) a receipted funeral bill or (b) an affidavit executed by a licensed funeral director which sets forth that satisfactory arrangements for payment of funeral services has been made.
